Division 1 grades 3-5





What will your Odyssey team do?


- Work together to solve problems! (long term and spontaneous)
- Meet once a week for 5 months from
 October to March. This may increase to
 2-3 days in Jan/Feb as the team gets ready
 for the Regional Tournament.
- Go to the local Regional Tournament to present their 8-minute long term problem solution and answer one unknown spontaneous problem.



What will your Odyssey team do?







Team members must design and create <u>all</u> aspects of their problem solution.

Be a coach!

2 coaches per team

Coaches are the real heros!

Be a judge!

2 judges per team – one for Spontaneous, one for Long Term

Must attend mandatory judge training on **February 3** at Robert Morris University, the

Regional Tournament on **March 2** and State Finals on **April 6** (only if your team advances)



Be a volunteer!

1 tournament volunteer per team to work at Regional Tournament on March 2 Other essential volunteer jobs: offer your home for meetings, provide team snacks, support coaches or help at summer Ingenuity Camp.


Kickoff Goals

Team Meetings



- Meet once a week from now through December, and more frequently if needed in in January and February.
- Pick a day & time that works for <u>your</u> team!
- Start meeting by the end of October. The more time you have to solve the problem, the better.


